


Crochet Class Highlights








GAIP Information

If you wish to receive a 1099 for the 2025 tax year, you must have all required documents submitted to grant administrator Vanessa Elam by December 1st. Her office is located in the same building as the Morgan Co. Water District. The final deadline to submit receipts for the 2025 funding cycle is March 2, 2026.







Deadline to register is Dec. 5th!!





